Our website runs from July to July. When it was renewed last July, they increased the price from \$648 to \$810. That's an increase of 25%. So we have the site till July. At that point, it probably doesn't make any sense to renew it. At the last count I had, we had 48 memberships in 2023 of which 17 were for a couple. That means we had 65 (48 + 17) total members and collected 31 * \$20 plus 17 * \$30 = \$1130. This covers the insurance and post office box, but will not cover the website.
