Thank you for your participation in the 12th annual "Celebration of Cycling Ride" sponsored by Programs to Educate All Cyclists. This ride raised funds to help people with disabilities become cyclists. You may have seen many of our participants out enjoying the bike ride with you, and hopefully you had an opportunity to speak to some of our participants or their families.

Our club challenge had more interest than ever before! Southeast Michigan bicycle clubs showed more support than ever, and clubs rode more than 9,000 miles total!

The winner for most miles was Ann Arbor Bicycle Touring Society with 2,341 miles!

The winner for highest percentage of club participation is the Downriver Cycling Club with 38 out of 162 club members participating, or 23.4%!
